United Methodist Women Celebrating 150 Years!

On March 23, 1869, eight women gathered at the Tremont Methodist Episcopal Church in Boston, Massachusetts, and organized the Women's Foreign Missionary Society, what would become United Methodist Women. From our very beginnings this organization has been one that has put "Faith, Hope, and Love In Action!" Those women raised money to send a doctor, Clara Swain, and a teacher, Isabella Thoburn, to India as missionaries to serve the women of that nation. Since then, United Methodist Women has evolved to become the largest women's faith-based service and advocacy organization (now numbering over 800,00), underwriting programs that provide life-changing opportunities for women, children and youth.
